







Square Weaving Instructions - Continuous Yarn Method

How to start a square weaving

		
<p>Make a large slip-knot loop. Tighten it around opposing diagonal corners.</p>	<p>Take yarn around first pin on lower left, run it up and around the first pin to the upper left. Use hook to pull yarn under what is now the center warp.</p>	<p>Loop it around the first pin on the upper right. Pull it down to the next pin on the lower right. The yarn is pre-woven where it will go back through the warp at the bottom.</p>
		
<p>Loop around the next pin on the lower left. Then take it up to the next pin on the upper left and weave through again.</p>	<p>Like this. Each loop is woven in the same way.</p>	<p>Weaving through later on. Just keep going and use a single yarn for the last strand. Tie or weave in the ends.</p>
